

MOUNT AIRY POKER HOUSE RULES

1.	<i>All players are to be true to their table stakes, no transferring money.</i>
2.	<i>No racks allowed at the poker table all chips must stay in play at all times.</i>
3.	<i>Seating & table change requests will be done through a supervisor or above.</i>
4.	<i>Players are responsible to protect their own hand. There will be no redress to money in the pot if an unprotected hand becomes mucked.</i>
5.	<i>Cards speak for themselves, if the pot has been rewarded mistakenly; it will be corrected immediately to the proper player by supervisor or above only.</i>
6.	<i>A player must buy-in for at least the minimum amount required for that specific game.</i>
7.	<i>Any chips crossing the yellow betting line will become part of the pot. Any cards thrown face down towards the pile of discarded cards or over the line will NOT be retrievable. This will be considered a fold and the dealer will muck the cards.</i>
8.	<i>The dealer may only give information about the hand when the action is facing that player.</i>
9.	<i>Verbal declarations if done in turn are binding.</i>
10.	<i>Only one player per hand.</i>
11.	<i>English only at the poker table while cards are in play.</i>
12.	<i>Check and raise is allowed.</i>
13.	<i>All cards must remain in full view of the dealer at all times.</i>
14.	<i>No cell phones, eating, or tobacco use (including chewing tobacco) will be allowed at the poker table.</i>
15.	<i>A seat will be saved for a player for up to 30 minutes.</i>
16.	<i>A player acting out of turn may be responsible for that bet or raise, if the action has not changed in front of them.</i>
17.	<i>Any player may not speak about the hand while the hand is in play.</i>
18.	<i>A player who depletes his/her funds will be considered all-in.</i>
19.	<i>A player must be seated in his/her seat PRIOR to the delivery of the first card in order to receive cards.</i>
20.	<i>Mount Airy does NOT operate under the No Flop No Drop policy.</i>
21.	<i>A percentage rake will not exceed 10% of the pot up to \$5.</i>
22.	NO RABBIT HUNTING.

BAD BEAT JACKPOT RULES OF PARTICIPATION

The jackpot will be funded by all cash Texas holdem games. A maximum of \$2 will be removed from each pot, \$1 at the \$10 pot level and an additional \$1 at the \$50 pot level. If the pot does not reach ten dollars, that round is not eligible for the Bad Beat Jackpot.

This \$2 will be placed in the designated area on the table and remain on the layout until each hand is over.

The dealer will drop the jackpot in the appropriate slot before beginning a new hand.

The jackpot will be paid out when a Bad Beat hand occurs. The qualifying hand is quad five's or better.

All four cards must play, and any players representing Four-Of-A-Kind must have a pocket pair.

Both hole cards have to be used in making the best 5 card poker hand. Minimum of (4) players must be dealt into the hand for the Bad Beat Jackpot to be valid.

Mount Airy Casino & Resort reserves the right to cancel the payment of the Bad Beat Jackpot at any time.

THE FUND WILL BE PAID AS FOLLOWS:

60 % to the loser of the hand

30% to the winner of the hand

10% divided evenly to all others players dealt into the hand

In the event a multiple Bad Beat hand hits simultaneously *, the 60% 30% and 10% payouts will be divided equally to all winners, however if a Bad Beat hand has already been awarded and another Bad Beat hand hits, the same percentages will be awarded out of the re-seeding jackpot.

*Simultaneously is defined as if the initial Bad Beat payout is pending but not yet distributed to the recipients.

A player must be dealt into the hand to be eligible for payout.



GOOD BEAT JACKPOT RULES OF PARTICIPATION

Win more; win often with the Good Beat Jackpot. Funded from live Texas Holdem cash games, 18 hands of Poker qualify daily if you are the first to attain that hand. Below are the rules and guidelines for participation. If you have an active interest in a hand and you have a "pocket pair" and/or your two "hole cards" contribute to making the winning hand, you have an opportunity to win.

Eighteen (18) winning hands are possible:

- (4) Royal flush of each suit (diamonds, clubs, hearts and spades.)
- (1) Straight flush (first of any suit)
- (13) Quads (four of a kind, deuces through aces)

Each hand has its own progressive jackpot.

- Each hand is seeded with \$50.00, initially.
- Each day if one of the eighteen (18) hands is not awarded due to a "hit," \$25.00 is added to the progressive jackpot at the start of the new gaming day.
- When a hand is hit and awarded it will be re-seeded with \$50.00 from the good beat fund at the start of the new gaming day.
- Each hand's jackpot is updated daily.
- Each day is designated as a new day at the start of the gaming day: defined as after a new drop box is inserted into the gaming table for the beginning of the new gaming day.
- In order to be eligible for any particular prize the player must not have "folded" for that hand. The winning hand, however, is not required to go to "showdown."
- A player must have a "pocket pair" when representing Quads to be eligible to win that prize, and/or both hole cards must be part of the winning hand.
- Jackpot amounts will be displayed on selected "Scala(s)" throughout the property
- Good Beat and Bad Beat are mutually exclusive.
 - A minimum of four (4) players is required to have been dealt into the hand.
 - Good Beat jackpot payout is only eligible once the Bad Beat jackpot dollar (\$1.00) has been removed from the pot.
- Each prize may be hit once daily. As a prize comes off the Jackpot Board it will not be eligible to be hit until after the start of a new gaming day as defined above.
- Only action on live games will be considered for a prize.
 - Tournament games or special events are not considered live games.
- Mount Airy Casino Resort reserves the right to cancel payout of the Good Beat Jackpot at any time.

HIGH HAND & RANDOM SEAT DRAWING RULES OF PARTICIPATION

Win more; win often with the high hand promotions. Below are the rules and guidelines for participation. If you have an active interest in the hand, and you use both "hole cards" to create the high hand for that designated time period, you will have an opportunity to win!

When a high hand is hit and awarded, that time slot will be closed until the next qualifying gaming day. The high hand will then reset according to the posted prize pool. All prizes will be funded by Mount Airy Casino Resort promotions.

In order to be eligible for any particular prize the player must not have "folded" for that hand. The winning hand does not have to go to "showdown"

Player must use both "hole cards" when representing the high hand, to be eligible to win that prize.

In the event of a tie(s) the prize will be divided equally.

Player must be present in the poker room at time of payout.

Minimum of (4) players must be dealt into the hand for the high hand jackpot to be valid.

Each hand may only hit once during the designated times.

Jackpot amounts will be displayed on a bravo screen located in the poker room.

Prizes will be awarded by the poker room Supervisor or above. Players must have a players account to receive any jackpot / promotional payouts.

Random seat drawings will be a promotion that players can win a cash prize. A player must give the dealer a player's card to be logged into the bravo in order to win. The bravo computer system will select a random player; between the designated time frame for that promotion.

Only action on live cash games will be considered for a prize. Tournament or special events are not considered live games.

Mount Airy reserves the right to cancel payouts of the high hand and/or random seat drawings at any time.
